Judge Stephanie K. Bowman received her B.A. in Political Science from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 1997 and received her J.D. from DePaul University, College of Law in 2000.

Judge Bowman spent the first year of her legal career practicing immigration law at McKinney & Namei. In late 2001, she joined Barrett & Weber, LPA as an associate attorney where her practice focused on the fields of estate planning, zoning, real estate, business transactions and litigation. In 2006 she transitioned to a chambers law clerk to the Honorable Michael R. Barrett, United States District Judge. Judge Bowman was appointed to her first eight-year term as a United States Magistrate Judge for the Southern District of Ohio on October 29, 2010. Judge Bowman is the judicial advisor to the Re-Entry Court Program for the Cincinnati Division of the Southern District of Ohio.

Judge Bowman is a Fellow of the Cincinnati Academy of Leadership for Lawyers and currently serves as Chair of the Steering Committee. She is a past president and member of the Ohio Women's Bar Association and sits on the board of the Cincinnati-Northern Kentucky John W. Peck Chapter of the Federal Bar Association. Judge Bowman is also a member of the Cincinnati Bar Association, the Federal Magistrate Judges Association, and the Potter Stewart American Inn of Court. Judge Bowman was named an Ohio Rising Star by Super Lawyers in 2005.
