As the 155th member of the Ohio Supreme Court, Justice Judi French was elected to her first full six-year term in 2014. Justice French joined the Supreme Court in 2013 after her appointment by Gov. John Kasich to fill a vacancy.

She has served as an appellate judge, counselor to the governor, an assistant attorney general, and a state government lawyer. Her experience also includes working as a corporate attorney and in private practice.

The daughter of a schoolteacher, Justice French appreciates her Ohio roots and education, and she is committed to being a part of civic education in Ohio. As a justice, she speaks frequently to students from around Ohio, particularly those studying the Ohio judicial system.

She received three degrees from Ohio State University, a bachelor's in political science, a master's in history and her law degree. Having learned from so many talented teachers and professors, Justice French is dedicated to serving as a resource to them and their students.
