The Ohio Women's Bar Foundation is accepting applications for its Law Student Scholarship, which is presented this year by Vorys, Sater, Seymour and Pease LLP. The scholarship is awarded annually to a female law student in Ohio whom has demonstrated commitment to promoting the missions of the OWBF and OWBA, and whom aspires to promote diversity and inclusion efforts in their future legal practice or brings a unique perspective to the law as a result of their diverse background or experience. The 2018 Law Student Scholarship will be given to one law student in the amount of **\$2,500**.

The deadline to submit an online application is **April 13, 2018**, and the recipient will be recognized at the Annual Meeting Luncheon on April 27, 2018, at the Nationwide Hotel and Conference Center.

Formed in 2008, the Ohio Women's Bar Foundation mission is to research, analyze, compile, publish and distribute educational materials to enable women attorneys and those interested in encouraging women attorneys to become more proficient in their profession with the assistance of their local and national woman's bar associations. The OWBF is a 501 (c)(3).

The OWBA was formed in 1991 to build a community of lawyers who are interested in the issues that uniquely affect women. The mission of the OWBA is to promote the leadership, advancement and interests of women attorneys through professional education, networking and the exchange of ideas between our members, local bar associations, business and the community. This includes:

- Fostering communications and networking among women attorneys.
- Promoting and advancing professional opportunities for women attorneys.
- Promoting the appointment and selection of women to various federal, state and local positions of influence.
- Promoting women as leaders.
- Promoting and providing continuing legal education targeting areas of particular interest to women attorneys.
- Monitoring and supporting government legislation, policies, and practices affecting women.
- Serving as a statewide resource representing perspectives of women in the legal profession.
