Ms. Elizabeth Sams is a Contracting Officer in the B-2 Division, Bombers Directorate, Air Force Life Cycle Management Center (AFLCMC), Air Force Materiel Command (AFMC), Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB), OH. She serves as the business leader providing administration and oversight of the \$9.9B Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract and the \$21.5M Enterprise Support Delivery Order, providing Modernization, Avionics and Armament, as well as Sustainment and Enterprise Support across the entire B-2 platform. She also leads contractual oversight of a \$3.5B portfolio of over 11,000 B-2 Government Furnished Property and Equipment items.

Previously, she served as a Contract Specialist in Big Safari, ISR/SOF Directorate, implementing over \$257M in net obligations through execution of over 95 contract actions while managing a \$92M contract portfolio. Her skills include an expert working knowledge of sole source and competitive contracting for system and subsystem acquisitions. She has experience with Major Weapon System and Subsystem contracts, as well as Operational and Enterprise Systems contracts.

Further, she was competitively selected as one of only 9 multi-functional acquisition professionals for the Advanced Tactical Acquisition Corps (ATAC-9). During this twelve week immersion program, the ATAC-9 team devised and implemented an acquisition strategy for the transition of a non-invasive infectious disease screening technology providing results in seconds, and briefed the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force, as well as other senior leaders. She also developed and briefed her personal leadership philosophy.

Prior to entering civil service, she practiced as a bankruptcy attorney, assisting clients with personal and corporate bankruptcy cases in the Southern District of Ohio, and served as the Vice Chair of the Bankruptcy and Consumer Law Committee for the Dayton Bar Association. She also served as a Guardian Ad Litem in Montgomery County, Ohio, protecting the best interests of children in abuse, neglect, and dependency cases, delinquency cases, and domestic relations matters.
